In August of 2007 the Hortons moved to begin their full time work in Bonners Ferry, finally completing a beautiful temple consecrated by His Eminence Archbishop JOSEPH the weekend of the Holy Myrrhbearers in May 2011.

As Fr. Gregory writes, "Our humble parish still serves families from as far away as Orofino, Idaho (about 3-4 hours away) and Creston, British Columbia (a little over two hours away). Missionary work to these and other outlying areas remains one of our main priorities as we seek to glorify God in this little corner of the world!"

# >Things to Bring <


- \* Warm clothes (March can be very chilly in the mountains)
